Two dead after speeding bus overturns in Karol Bagh

One was getting ready for his wedding a month away. The other went to celebrate Eid, leaving behind his pregnant wife. On Wednesday, the stories of hope met a tragic end when a speeding bus overturned near Hanuman Mandir in Karol Bagh, killing the two men returning home from Jaipur.

In the intervening night of Tuesday and Wednesday, a Delhi-bound tourist bus coming from Jaipur, allegedly being driven at a speed of around 100 km/h, went out of control at a roundabout

near the temple and flipped two to three times in the air, police said. Besides the two, the accident left 23 more injured — 13 of them in a semi-critical state. "Maiya intezar kar rahi

thi, beta subah aajayega (Mother was waiting for my son to come in the morning)," Mahesh's mother said, breaking down as she spoke about her youngest son. The Bareilly native had boarded the bus with his 30-year-old brother Mukesh in Haryana's Bilaspur, where they both worked. Blood stains on Mukesh's clothes testified to the horror of the crash.

during which the driver got drunk. The bus had no functional emergency exit, he also claimed. "My brother was trapped under the bus with many others. There was a woman whose legs were visible while the rest of her body was pinned underneath. I tried to pull people out and then took my brother to the hospital in an ambulance," Mukesh, who managed to crawl out of the mangled vehicle, said. The police denied the claim that the driver was drunk, citing his medico-legal report. An officer said that while the bus did have an emergency exit, its doors jammed after the accident. A mechanical inspection of the vehicle will be conducted to ascertain any technical faults, he added.

Budget nearly triples allocation for tourism sector, says Kapil Mishra

The Delhi Budget 2026-27 has nearly tripled allocation for the tourism sector, Tourism Minister Kapil Mishra said on Wednesday, highlighting enhanced funding for cultural programmes and public amenities across the city. Announcing the budget on Tuesday, Chief Minister Rekha Gupta said ₹412 crore has been allocated for the tourism department, up from ₹121 crore last year, along with a provision of ₹173 crore for the art, culture and language department.



culture and tourism sectors were previously overlooked. Highlighting the provisions of the budget, the minister said the budget mandates the tourism department to develop world-class public convenience facilities at nearly 1,000 locations across the Capital. Additionally, around 21 per cent of the total outlay has been earmarked as "green

budget", with departments such as public works, flood control and the Delhi Jal Board incorporating components aimed at reducing pollution. Provisions have also been made for setting up rest centres for gig workers across the city under the labour department, Mishra added. He said feedback from traders, women and youth following the budget has been positive, adding that these measures would help strengthen Delhi's development trajectory. The Delhi airport handled around 32 lakh foreign tourist arrivals in 2024, the highest in the country, according to the Economic Survey of Delhi 2025-26 presented on Monday.

Assembly receives fresh bomb threat email

The Delhi Assembly received a fresh bomb threat email on Wednesday, prompting intensive checks even as House proceedings were underway, a day after a similar threat surfaced just hours before Chief Minister Rekha Gupta's scheduled budget presentation, officials said.



picious was found. It turned out to be a hoax, said a senior police officer. Assembly Speaker Vijender Gupta, informing the House about the bomb threat, said, "The email was sent to the Speaker's Office

at the Delhi Assembly mentioning certain organisations allegedly linked to Naxalites and Pakistan-based units." The email claimed 16 RDX-IEDs had been planted, with a plan to trigger blasts at 1:40 pm. Gupta said it was a clear instruction of the House to the police to investigate the matter from every possible angle. "It is imperative to unmask the terrorist and anti-national forces that are being encouraged or supported through various channels within this country," he said.

The Speaker said that the Assembly Secretariat has already forwarded the emails, including one sent on Tuesday, to the police and its cybercrime team was also probing the matter. On the threat mail, Delhi Environment Minister Manjinder Singh Sirsa alleged that AAP could be behind the threats. "Such threats at the time when Chief Minister Rekha Gupta presented the Delhi budget were not natural. The probe should also investigate if there was any role of AAP in it," he said.

Police bust LPG black-marketing racket

Delhi Police has busted an illegal LPG hoarding and black marketing racket in south-west Delhi's Chhawla area, recovering 65 cylinders and arresting a 52-year-old man accused of selling gas at inflated prices. The raid was carried out on March 24 by a joint team of the Anti-Auto Theft Squad (AATS) of Dwarka district and local police from Chhawla, following specific intelligence about illegal storage and sale



of LPG cylinders from a residential premises. Dwarka DCP Kushal Pal Singh said the district police had intensified surveillance on hoarding and black marketing of essential commodities. "We are maintaining strict vigil and taking action against illegal activities involving essential supplies," he said, adding that such operations will continue to

ensure public safety. Police identified the accused as Ashok Kumar, a resident of Etawah in Uttar Pradesh, who was operating from a house in Kashmiri Colony on Paprawat Road in Prem Nagar, Chhawla. According to officials, the premises were being used to stockpile both domestic and commercial LPG cylinders. The accused allegedly procured cylinders through unauthorised channels and sold them to local residents at higher rates.
