# Jallianwala Bagh - A Turning Point in India's Struggle for Freedom

The Jallianwala Bagh massacre, a pivotal event in India's struggle for independence, occurred on April 13, 1919, in Amritsar, Punjab. On that day, British troops led by Brigadier-General Reginald Dyer opened fire on a crowd of unarmed Indians gathered at Jallianwala Bagh, killing hundreds and injuring many more. The crowd had assembled to protest the Rowlatt Act, a law that allowed the British to arrest and detain Indians without trial, and to demand the release of two nationalist leaders, Satyapal and Saifuddin Kitchlew. The events leading up to the massacre began with the 1915 Defence of India Act and the 1919 Rowlatt Act, aimed at curbing civil liberties and suppressing Indian nationalism. The British government feared another uprising like the 1857 mutiny. The Rowlatt Act sparked widespread protests and unrest across India, particularly in Punjab. Mahatma Gandhi called for

nationwide protests and disobedience against the Rowlatt Acts. The response was strongest in Punjab, with leaders like Kichloo and Satyapal addressing mass rallies in Lahore and Amritsar. Gandhi planned to address a rally in Amritsar but was arrested at the border and taken back to Bombay. On April 10, 1919, protests erupted in Amritsar, and an English missionary was attacked. General Dyer imposed Martial Law on April 12, 1919. The next day, a large crowd gathered at Jallianwala Bagh, unaware of the ban on public meetings. General Dyer arrived with 90 soldiers, blocked the entrance, and ordered them to fire on the crowd. The massacre resulted in at least 400 deaths and over 1,000 injuries.

The Jallianwala Bagh massacre was a turning point in India's freedom struggle. It led to increased support for the Indian National Congress and the non-cooperation movement, ultimately contributing to India's independence in 1947. The Jallianwala Bagh massacre was a tragic event that shook the foundations of British rule in India and galvanized the nation's struggle for independence. The brutal suppression of unarmed civilians sparked widespread outrage and resistance, marking a turning point in India's fight for freedom. As we remember the sacrifices of those who lost their lives, we are reminded of the importance of freedom, justice, and human rights. The legacy of Jallianwala Bagh serves as a reminder of the power of courage and resilience in the face of oppression, inspiring future generations to continue striving for a more just and equitable society. # Suicide of Swami of Swaminarayan Temple

This suicide is suspicious, conduct proper investigation: Welfare Committee; He took sleeping pills a few days ago in Surat

The mysterious suicide of 48-year-old Sadhu Priyadarshan Swami at the Swaminarayan Mission Temple in Laskana area of 75Surat city has created a stir. He had fallen unconscious after swallowing a large quantity of sleeping pills on April 26. After prolonged treatment, he breathed his last in the hospital on May 15. Following the incident, a case of accidental death has been registered at the Laskana police station and further investigation has been conducted.

of the temple should be checked, statements of all the saints and servants of the temple should be recorded, and if any person is mentally harassing, threatening, pressurizing or blackmailing them, then legal action should be taken against them.

The police have registered a case of accidental death and intensified the investigation.

Based on the information received from BAPS Hospital, Laskana Police Station has registered an accidental death and handed over the further investigation to Police Sub Inspector A.D. Solanki. The police have started the process of conducting a panel postmortem on the body of the monk to find out the real reason behind the suicide. Such an incident in the temple has caused a lot of panic among the devotees.

The initial conclusion is suicide and a panel postmortem has been conducted. PI Minaba Jhala of Laskana Police Station said that in the initial investigation, it is suspected that Priyadarshan Swami committed suicide. However, a panel postmortem has been conducted and the exact reason will be revealed after the postmortem report.

On May 15, the doctor declared Swami dead. ACP Vinay Patel said that on April 26, Priyadarshan Swami, who lived in the premises of the Mission School near Valak Patiya, tried to end his life by consuming an unknown substance.

Following which, a case was first registered at Laskana Police Station and his treatment was going on in different hospitals. On May 15, the doctor declared him dead at BAPS Hospital Adajan.

Following which, a case of accidental death has been registered at Laskana Police Station and the incident is being investigated by PSI Solanki.

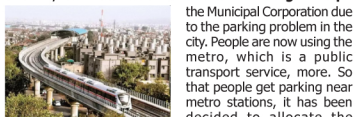

The traffic problem in Ahmedabad city is increasing day by day. Especially the parking problem is being seen. Prime Minister Narendra Modi has appealed to the people to use public transport services to save fuel. So that people can park their vehicles around the city's metro stations and go to the metro stations, the Municipal Corporation has started looking for parking plots from 100 meters to 500 meters away near metro stations including Vastral, Sabarmati, Thaltej, Instrukments were given earlier to find parking plots, so that more people can use the metro, following which now these parking plots have been developed and planned so that people can park for free.

Although the municipal authorities did not see the public's pain for parking for 7 years, they have even found parking plots overnight after the advice of PM Modi. It is worth mentioning that the metro was started in 2019.

The corporation has currently identified 17 parking plots where the process of installing paver blocks, parking signs and CCTV will be carried out so that vehicle drivers can park.

## Partial relief from heat, temperature drops by one and a half to two degrees

Ahmedabad-Rajkot hottest with 41.7°C; Heatwave warning in Saurashtra-Kutch today

Ahmedabad, The people of Gujarat, who have been facing the scorching heat for a long time, have got some relief. In the last 24 hours, the maximum temperature in the state has decreased by one and a half to two degrees. According to the temperature recorded on Friday, May 15, the mercury has come down from 44 degrees Celsius to 42°C. Yesterday, the highest temperature in the state was recorded in Ahmedabad-Rajkot. The maximum temperature here was 41.7°C. The temperature in six cities has crossed 40°C.

Kutch and Kandla Port in Kutch. Apart from this, heatwave was also prevalent in isolated places in Vadodra district of South Gujarat, Dwarka (Okha) in Saurashtra and Diu. The maximum temperature recorded was significantly higher than normal in some parts of Saurashtra and Kutch.



Weather forecast for the next 7 days (till May 22, 2026)  
The weather is likely to remain completely dry in Gujarat, Saurashtra-Kutch and Union Territories. There may be a gradual decrease in the maximum temperature by 2 to 3 degrees Celsius during the next 2 days, after which there is no possibility of any major change in the temperature. However, the maximum temperature is likely to exceed 40°C in some areas of Gujarat during the next 5 days.
